**Dinosaur Tracks from Cretaceous Sediments of Peace River Canyon Near Hudson Hope, British Columbia**

Dinosaur tracks first were described from the Peace River Canyon in 1926, but have received little subsequent study. Because the early described localities were threatened with submergence following construction of a new dam, a "rescue" expedition to cast or collect as many trackways as possible was sent out by the Provincial Museum of Alberta in September 1976. New discoveries included a 12 x 6-m bedding-plane surface with more than 70 hadrosaur footprints of types not hitherto described from this region.
